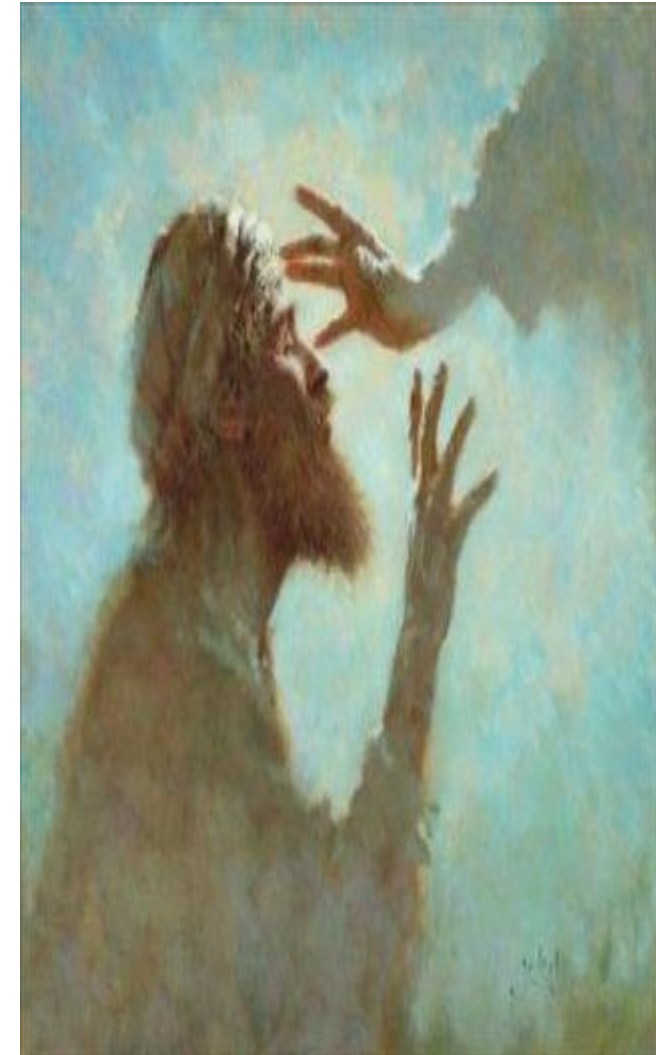
You are welcome to join us for worship on Sundays at 11:00
